Jeffery Adams was named vice president, Corporate Communications, in August 2020. He reports to the Postmaster General and chief executive officer.

In this role, Adams oversees all internal and external communications and directs the Corporate Communications team nationwide, including Public Relations, National Events, Field Communications, Digital Communications, Employee Communications and Content Management, and Strategic and Crisis Communications.
